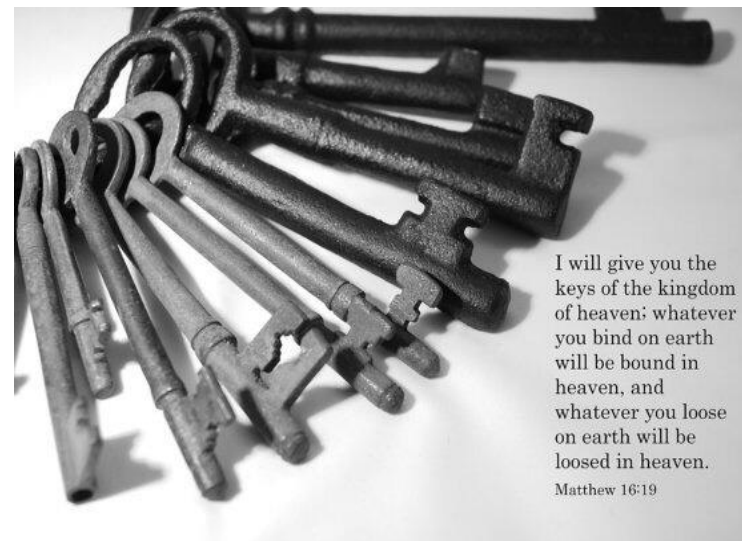

SPECIAL REQUEST FOR YOUR CONSIDERATION THIS SABBATH:

Dear Nambour Church Family,

Our Nambour Church Business Meeting made an important decision at the meeting last Monday evening that will contribute to a more comfortable and pleasant worship experience for us all. I want to share this with you.

First, the group at the meeting decided to accept the proposal from a consultant for air conditioning our church with units installed in the ceiling rather than the walls. This system is not only quieter, but is also more effective at spreading the cooling evenly across our church floor.

Second, the group decided that this improvement would best be funded by a special appeal to our members. Consequently, this Sabbath you will be asked if you would be willing to make a special donation for this project sometime between now and the end of January.

The entire project will cost just under \$25,000. However, the members voted to cover the balance of the costs from our Church Expense Fund provided that we can raise the initial \$18,000 from this special sacrificial offering. The members there felt strongly that we should not take the full amount from our current funds as that would leave us with too little for our ongoing expenses.

The plan is to commence the installation as soon as we have pledges for \$18,000 and to have the project completed by the end of November so that we can enjoy the coolness this summer. I know that this is something that will enhance the attractiveness of our church and the enjoyment of our worship experience. I personally look forward to being able to worship in a cooler environment and will be making a personal pledge and ask you to join me in this endeavour. I know that you will prayerfully consider what you can do for your church and be ready to make your pledge this Sabbath.
