White Ribbon Day is 25th November each year, which is the United Nations International Day for the Elimination of Violence against Women. It is the day when the silent majority of non-violent men can, by wearing a white ribbon, make a statement to all men that –

- They will never excuse violence against women & children,
- And they will never remain silent about violence against women and children.
