Dearest Folks by Margaret Watts

Letters home from a missionary wife and mother...
 The letters collected in Dearest Folks touch my emotions deeply. I am profoundly impressed by author Margaret Watts' tenacity and courage. These letters were written by hand or tapped out on a typewriter, then often took weeks to get to her loved ones at home in Australia. They could not know what was happening or how her heart was hurting, frightened or sad because of a sick child with no medical help nearby or when a cyclone hit or a tidal wave threatened to engulf her home and clinic. They found out only much later about her panic when her baby almost drowned or about the loneliness she experienced when her husband Horrie was away in that small mission ship yet again...
